Overview

The Landscape Industry Certified Technician evaluation is administered by Landscape Manitoba. Certification seeks to recognize proficiency in the horticulture workforce, upgrade the status of the horticulture professional and provide the public with a means of identifying qualified industry professionals. Each program has been developed by industry volunteers to identify those individuals with acceptable knowledge of principles and practices.

The Landscape Industry Certified Technician evaluation is designed for business owners and their employees working in Hardscape Installation, Softscape Installation, Turf Maintenance, Ornamental Maintenance, Retail Garden Centre and Interior Landscaping sectors. In order to qualify for a Landscape Industry Certified Technician designation, candidates must pass a proficiency test composed of both practical and written evaluations.

The upcoming evaluation will test both the Softscape Installation and Hardscape Installation modules.
